# LIBRARY

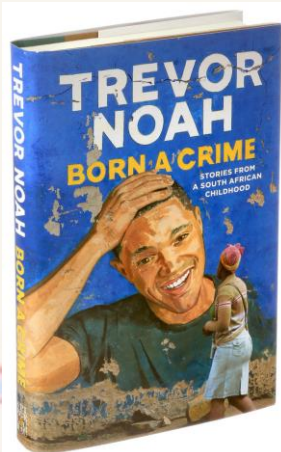

6. Deadline for submission of forms Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

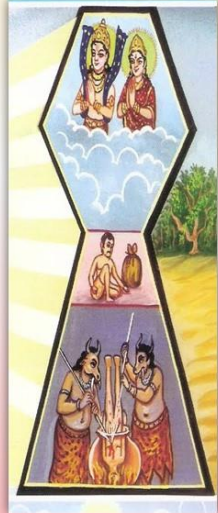
