The story of a dancer who can tell stories without uttering a word



You can achieve anything that you desire as long as you put everything in it.

Mili Shah is a dance legend in making and her persistence in telling stories through dance has made her tour the world and express herself in one of the most prestigious award platforms for the Hindi Film Industry - 2016 IIFA Awards in Madrid, Spain. She has also worked with a renown choreographer called Shiamak Davar.

At the age of 6, she discovered the magic in dance. "I was probably around 6 years old and had made up my mind that I am going to use this form to express my stories to the world. This craving led me to the best dancing school in Nairobi, The Kamini School of Dancing. To start of, I had to train in Bharat Natyam, a classical Indian form of dancing that would help build the foundation for the rest of the dancing styles I learned along the way." Mili wrote.

After 12 years of hard work, she developed the skill of narrating dance stories that made the audience shed tears and get engulfed in laughter. She was able to breakdown any literature work through dance. "In 2012 I did my Arangetram, which is equivalent to graduating from university but for dancing.

Seeing tears and laughter in the audience during my performances made me realize that I have found a way of telling a compelling story without uttering a word. However, the most important factor was that I could connect to a hall filled with 200+ people at the same time." She wrote.



She later moved to UK for further studies. Her talent could not allow her to concentrate on her degree alone, the desire to follow her passion made her double up university studies with dance. "I decided to join the Shiamak Davar Dance Academy, one of the hardest dance schools in the world to get into. It is run by Shiamak Davar, the biggest dance choreographer in India who trains a lot of Bollywood stars.

We began performing several shows around London to packed auditoriums that could accommodate anywhere from 300-500 people. The most surprising bit for me was that the tickets would sell out within a few hours of release. It was amazing to see that so many people actually appreciated dance as an art of expressing and enjoyed watching us just as they would any actor or actress on screen." She added.

She comments that everybody has the capability of doing great things in life only if you set the right goals and put enough sacrifice.

"From my journey I can definitely say that if i can do it anyone can. It's not about your aptitude but your attitude."
